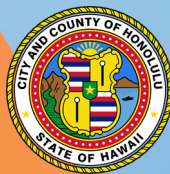

OUR GOALS

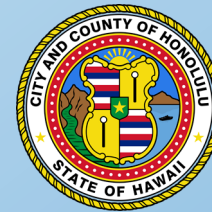
To eliminate or minimize employment barriers so participants can enter the labor market

Advanced topics covered, if time permits, are managing stress and general area cleaning.

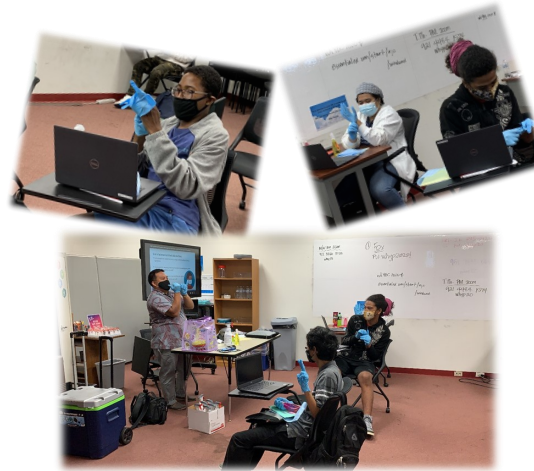

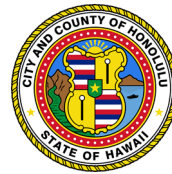
